"microplastics," measuring less than 5 mm in length. Because of their small size, microplastics can easily spread through the air, accumulate in the environment, and may be difficult to detect. They can be found in alcohol, drinking water, seafood species, and even table salt. Microplastics have also been intentionally manufactured for use in exfoliants, toothpaste, and other cosmetic products. When humans consume food, drink water, or breathe air that is contaminated with microplastics, the plastic fragments can enter the body, so they have been found in human saliva, head hair, and feces, suggesting that we are all likely exposed to these plastic fragments on a regular basis. Researchers show that human exposure to microplastics could lead to oxidative stress, DNA damage, and inflammation, among other health problems. A recent study has found that people eat 5 grams of microplastics every week. In laboratory tests, microplastics have been shown to cause damage to human cells, including allergic reactions, cell death, damaging cells, and inducing inflammatory and immune reactions.

According to European Food Safety Authority, still, we do not have enough information and data that explain how microplastics are present in food and how they affect human health. Therefore, it is very important to make more research to develop new standardization methods to analyze microplastics and determine their effect and risk on the human body.


